The United Nations is an international organization founded in 1945 after the Second World War. Its main objective is to promote peace and cooperation among nations, prevent conflicts and wars, and provide aid and assistance to those in need around the world.

The UN has six main bodies: the General Assembly, the Security Council, the International Court of Justice, the Secretariat, the Economic and Social Council, and the Trusteeship Council. Each of these bodies plays a specific role in promoting the goals of the organization.

The General Assembly is the main body of the UN, where all member countries come together to discuss and address global issues. The International Court of Justice settles legal disputes between states and gives advisory opinions on legal questions.

Did you know that, nowadays, famous technological companies are involved in agriculture innovation? With an ever-growing population all around the world, more food sources are desperately needed to overcome world hunger. Many famous high-tech companies are cultivating different kinds of vegetables and fruits, using a special technology named hydroponics. Although some may believe that hydroponics has many drawbacks, others view it as a practical way to solve a global problem: food shortage.

Hydroponics replaces traditional farming (which depends on soil, water, and light) with artificial solutions, and thus allows you to plant indoors and to have fresh vegetables and fruits. With this technology, planting can happen anywhere, including homes and restaurants. Also, seasonal fruits and vegetables can be available all year long in different climates. This is because finding alternatives to natural resources that all plants need can be an additional cost to farmers. Hydroponics farming also depends on electricity to replace the natural source of light, which puts plants at risk of dying if the power supply is unreliable. Moreover, the process of farming and monitoring the plants requires highly skilled farmers, and thus farmers with little or no knowledge of hydroponics will be at risk of being unemployed.

Serious social problems require creative solutions. Although hydroponics may have disadvantages, it is still one possible method that could help people live better lives.
