United Nations Relief and Works Agency for Palestine Refugees in the Near East (UNRWA), is an agency created by the United Nations (UN) in 1949 to provide relief, health, and education services for Palestinians who lost both their homes and means of livelihood after the war. Beginning operations in 1950, UNRWA was originally headquartered in Beirut, Lebanon, but was moved to Vienna, Austria, in 1978. In 1996 the General Assembly moved the agency to the Gaza Strip. UNRWA's member states include Belgium, Egypt, France, Japan, Jordan, Lebanon, Syria, Turkey, the United Kingdom, the United States, and several Arab states of the Persian Gulf region; the Palestinian Authority (PA). Around 500,000 Palestinians originally qualified for relief, but by 2015 there were more than five million registered Palestinian refugees, including the children of the original refugees. As the largest UN operation in the Middle East and one of the biggest employers in the region—with service operations in Jordan, Lebanon, Syria, the West Bank, and the Gaza Strip. UNRWA provides camps, food, clothing, schools, vocational training, and health clinics, often working in cooperation with the several other agencies related to the UN. UNRWA is financed by voluntary contributions of member governments.
