

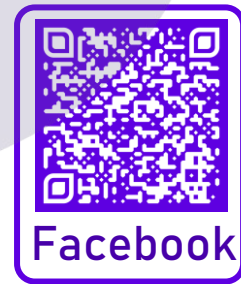
المحتويات
