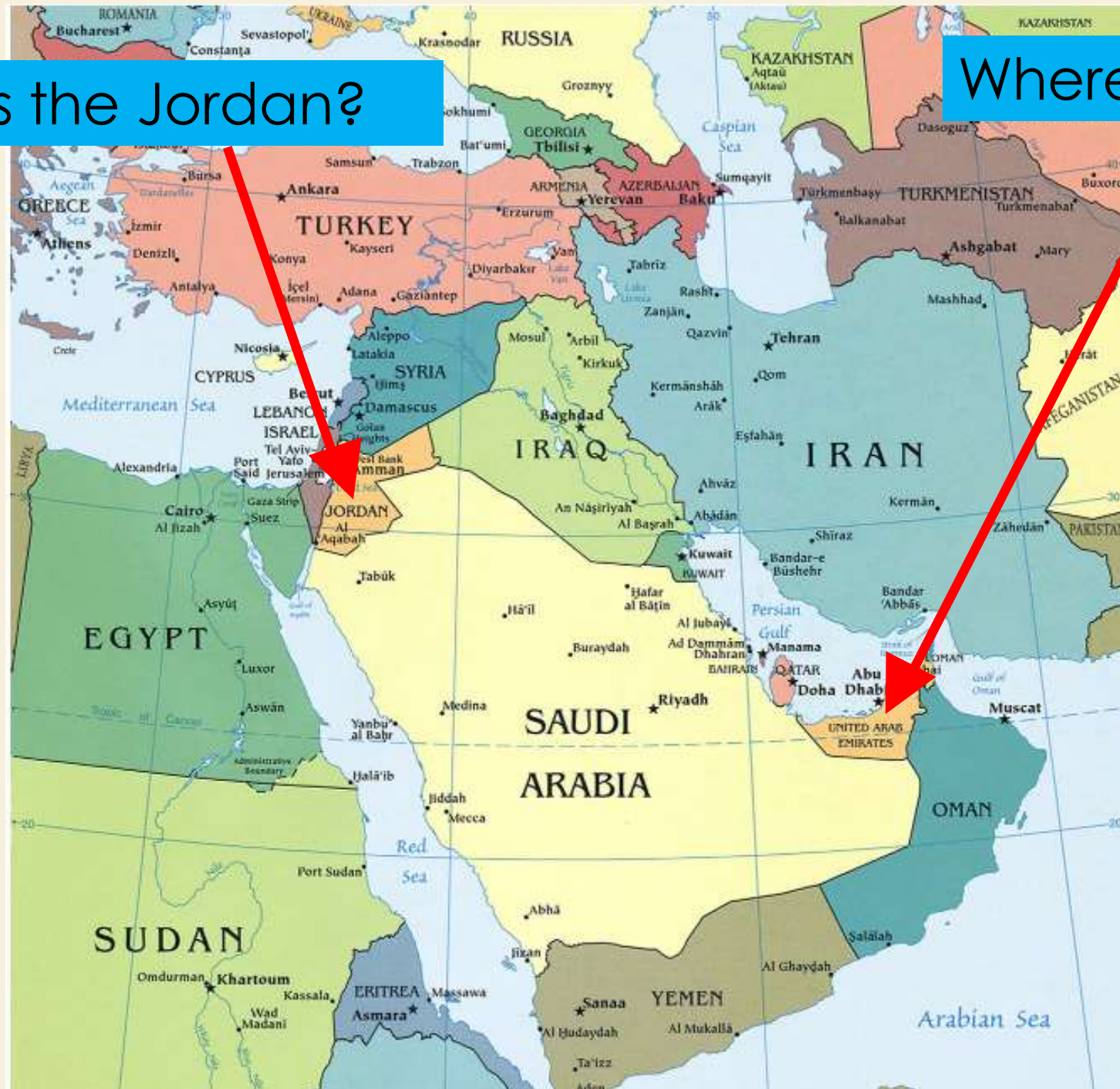

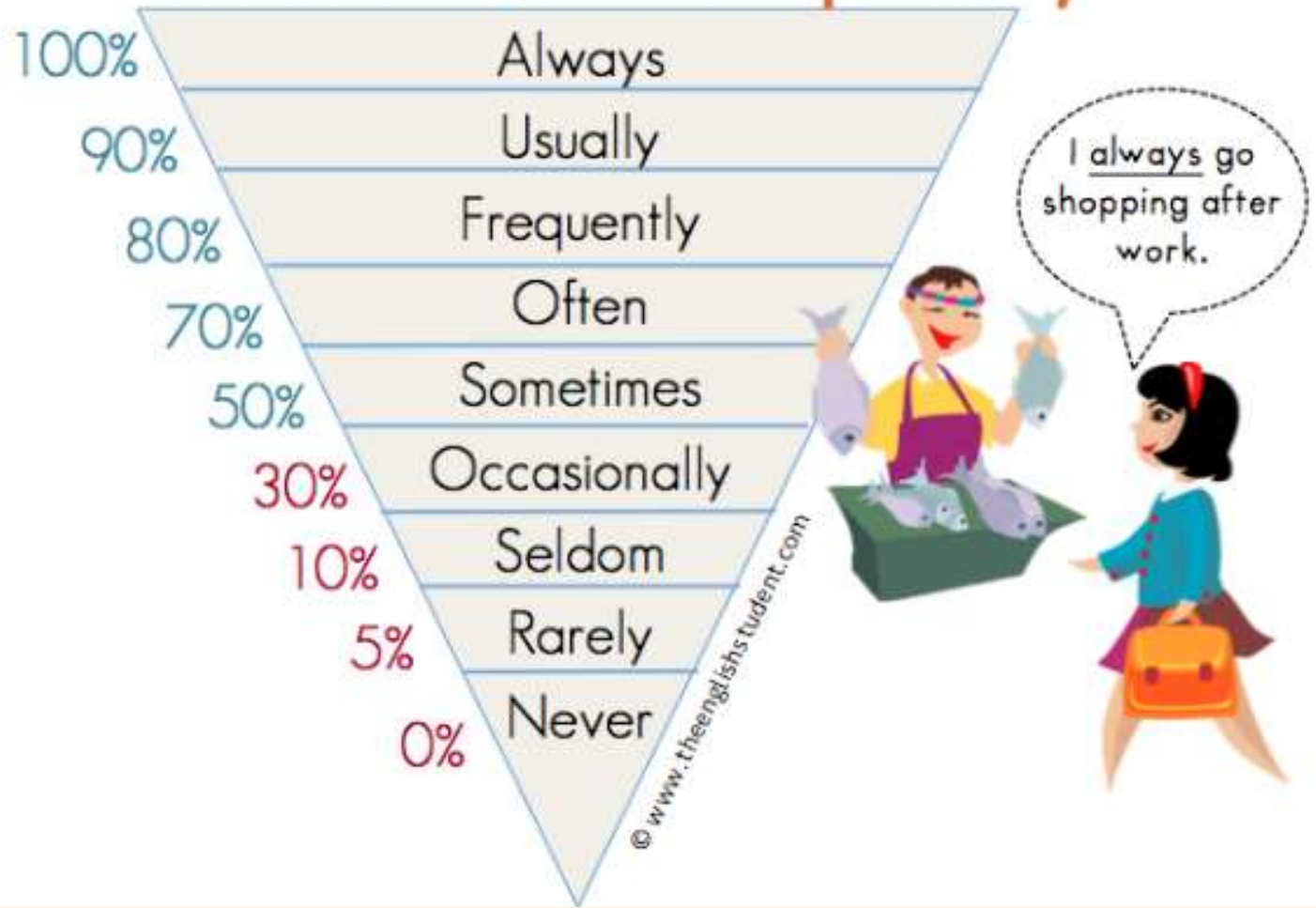
## Adverbs of Frequency

An adverb of frequency tells us how often something takes place.





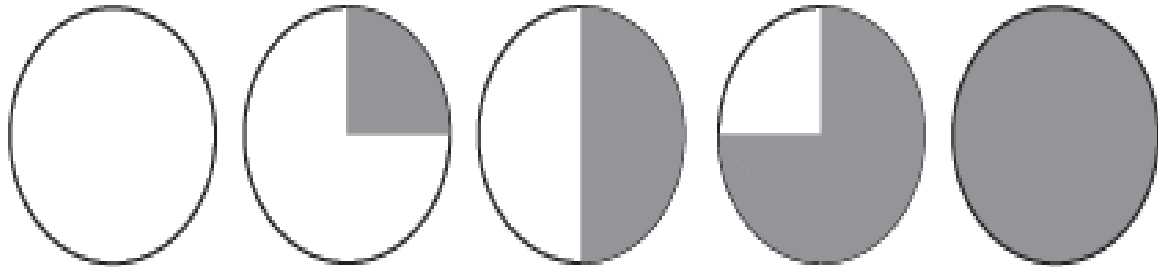

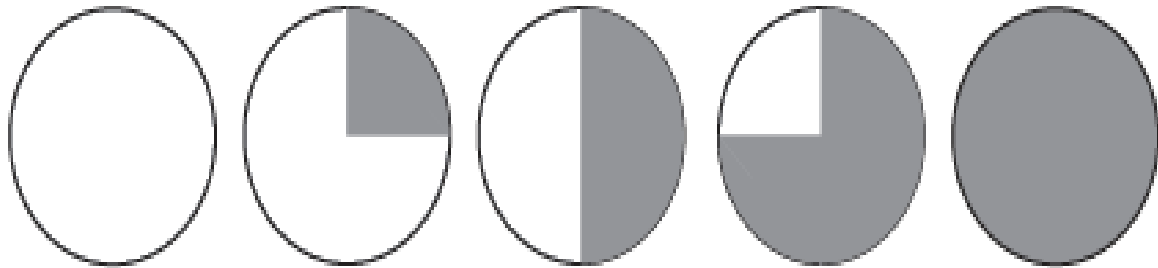
