The first spark started in the year 1950, when a test of the ability of a machine to exhibit intelligent behavior equivalent to that of a human was done. Since then, the term AI has been introduced and closely associated with the field of artificial intelligence which was popular until the end of the 1980s. In the 1990s, the new concept of "intelligent agent" emerged when AI was not only limited to computer science, but developed to include other areas like health, security, education, music, art, and business applications. Many AI applications are deeply embedded in the infrastructure of every industry, and they are expected, in a few years, to touch nearly all the industries.

However, AI technologies are still limited to very specific applications. One of the AI limitations is the lack of "common sense" the power to judge information beyond its acquired knowledge. AI is also limited in terms of emotional intelligence. Moreover, AI can only detect basic human emotional states such as anger, joy, sadness, stress, pain, fear, and neutrality. Emotional intelligence is one of the next hurdles to higher levels of personalization. Rational and harmonic interactions are required between application specific projects and research ideas to sustain the progress of AI.
